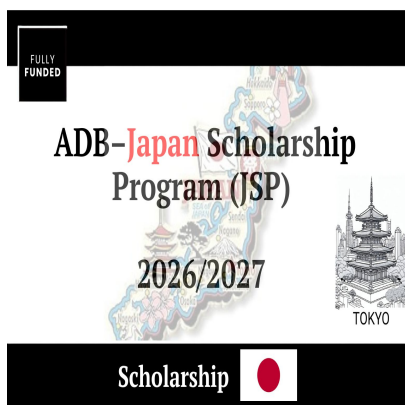




ADB-Japan Scholarship Program (JSP) 2026/2027 Application Call

Description

Amherst College offers generous need-based financial aid to international undergraduate students seeking to study in the United States. Hosted at Amherst College in Massachusetts, the program is designed to make a world-class liberal arts education accessible regardless of financial background. For the 2026-2027 admission cycle, eligible applicants can apply for financial aid alongside their undergraduate admission application. Students with strong academic records and demonstrated financial need may benefit from funding that can significantly reduce or fully cover the cost of attendance. Benefits

- **Tuition Fees:** Covers up to 100% of demonstrated financial need, including tuition for admitted international students.
- **Monthly Stipend / Living Allowance:** No fixed monthly stipend is provided. Living expenses are included in the financial aid package based on demonstrated financial need.
- **Travel or Airfare:** No travel or airfare funding is specified on the official financial aid page.
- **Health Insurance:** Health insurance costs may be included in the financial aid package based on demonstrated financial need.
- **Accommodation:** Housing and meal costs may be covered through the need-based financial aid package.
- **Visa, Books, Research or Settling-in Allowance:** No separate funding for visa fees, research, or settling-in expenses is specified. Books and other educational expenses may be considered when determining financial need.

Eligibility Criteria

- **Nationality:** Open to international students from all countries.
- **Academic Qualifications:** Applicants must have an outstanding secondary school academic record and meet Amherst College's undergraduate admission requirements.
- **Age Limit:** No specific age limit is stated on the official website.
- **Work Experience:** Not required.

- **Language Requirements:** Applicants whose first language is not English may need to demonstrate English language proficiency. Amherst accepts recognized English proficiency tests where applicable, according to its admissions policy.
- **Admission Requirements:** Applicants must apply for undergraduate admission to Amherst College and submit all required admission and financial aid documents by the applicable deadlines.
- **Financial Need:** Applicants seeking financial aid must demonstrate financial need through the required financial aid application process.
- **Nomination Route:** No nomination or institutional endorsement is required. Students apply directly to Amherst College.

Available Fields or Programmes

Amherst College's need-based financial aid is available to eligible international students admitted to **any undergraduate major** offered by the college. The official financial aid policy does **not** restrict funding to specific programmes or departments.

Note: International students may apply to any undergraduate programme offered by Amherst College, provided they meet the admission requirements. The financial aid award is not limited to specific academic disciplines.

How to Apply

1. **Choose Amherst College** as your preferred institution and review the undergraduate admission requirements.
2. **Complete the online undergraduate application** through the Common Application or Coalition Application during the relevant admission cycle.
3. **Indicate that you are applying for financial aid** within your admission application.
4. **Submit the required financial aid documents**, including the CSS Profile (or approved alternative, if applicable) and any supporting financial documents requested by Amherst College.
5. **Provide all required admission materials**, such as academic transcripts, recommendation letters, essays, and English language proficiency test scores (if applicable).
6. **Submit your application before the applicable admission and financial aid deadlines.**
7. **Monitor your application portal** for any additional document requests and admission updates.
8. **Receive the admission decision and financial aid award** if selected.

Application Route: Applicants apply directly to Amherst College. No embassy, government nomination, or external nominating agency is required. Required Documents

Applicants must submit the following documents as part of the undergraduate admission and financial aid application:

- Completed undergraduate application (Common Application or Coalition Application)
- Official secondary/high school transcripts
- School report
- Counselor recommendation
- Two teacher recommendation letters
- Personal essay
- Mid-year school report (if applicable)
- CSS Profile (for applicants requesting financial aid)
- Supporting financial documents (as requested by Amherst College)
- English language proficiency test results (if required based on the applicant's educational background)

Note: Amherst College follows a test-optional policy for SAT/ACT. A passport copy, CV, research proposal, and degree certificates are **not listed as required documents** for undergraduate applicants on the official admissions and financial aid pages.

Is this scholarship fully funded or tuition-only?

Amherst College's financial aid for international students is not a fixed scholarship with a standard package. It is a **need-based financial aid programme** that can cover up to **100% of a student's demonstrated financial need**. Depending on the applicant's financial situation, the aid package may include tuition, housing, meals, and other educational expenses. It is not limited to tuition fees only.

Which nationalities and study levels are eligible?

The financial aid opportunity is available to **international students from all nationalities** who apply for undergraduate admission to Amherst College in the United States. The programme is intended for **Bachelor's degree (undergraduate) students only**. Graduate, Ph.D., postdoctoral, and fellowship applicants are not eligible under this financial aid programme.

Is university admission required before the scholarship application?

Yes. Applicants must apply for admission to Amherst College first. Financial aid consideration is part of the undergraduate admission process, and students must indicate their intention to apply for financial aid and submit the required financial documents along with their admission application. A separate scholarship application is not required.

What is the exact deadline and timezone?

The application deadlines vary depending on the admission round. For the 2026-2027 admission cycle, applicants should submit their applications by the deadline specified by Amherst College through the official admissions portal. Deadlines are generally listed as **11:59 PM in the applicant's local time zone**.

Applicants should verify the latest deadline and timezone information on the official Amherst College Admissions website before submission.

Is there an application fee?

Yes. Amherst College has an undergraduate application fee. However, applicants who demonstrate financial need may request an application fee waiver through the application platform. International students should check the latest fee and waiver eligibility details on the official Amherst College admissions website before applying.
