



Call for Applications Canadian Indigenous Academic Groups

Description

The 2026 Canadian Indigenous Academic Groups program is an international academic exchange opportunity supported through Canada's international education initiatives in partnership with Mexico. The program is hosted in Mexico and is designed for Indigenous students and faculty members from eligible Canadian post-secondary institutions. The current 2026 call supports short-term academic and cultural exchanges, helping participants build international connections, share knowledge, and experience Indigenous perspectives across borders. Selected participants may receive financial assistance for eligible travel, transportation, and living costs during their stay.

Eligibility Criteria

- **Nationality:** Applicants must be Indigenous students or faculty members from **Canadian post-secondary institutions**. Eligible Indigenous groups include **First Nations, Inuit and MÃ©tis**.
- **Academic qualifications:** Applicants must be students or faculty members affiliated with a Canadian higher education institution. Specific degree/academic-grade requirements are **not stated** in the EduCanada announcement.
- **Age limit:** No specific age requirement is mentioned.
- **Work experience:** No specific work-experience requirement is mentioned.
- **Language requirements:** No specific English, French or Spanish language requirement is mentioned.
- **Admission requirement:** Applicants must be affiliated with an eligible Canadian post-secondary institution; this is a short-term academic/cultural stay rather than admission to a degree program.
- **Nomination route: Yes.** Canadian higher education institutions nominate the Indigenous students and faculty members. Groups consist of **one faculty member and up to two students**.

- **Group requirement:** The selected group undertakes an academic and cultural stay of up to **30 days** at a participating Mexican higher education institution.

Available Fields or Programmes

The official 2026 call **does not specify particular academic fields, disciplines, or degree programmes**. It only confirms short-term **academic and cultural stays** at participating Mexican higher education institutions, lasting up to 30 days.

Therefore:

- **Academic fields:** Not specified
- **Degree programmes:** Not specified
- **Exchange focus:** Academic cooperation, cultural exchange, student mobility, and Indigenous knowledge exchange.

How to Apply

This opportunity is **not a direct individual application**. Canadian higher education institutions must nominate eligible Indigenous students and faculty members. ([EduCanada](#))

1. **Check eligibility:** Applicants should be Indigenous students or faculty members at a Canadian post-secondary institution.
2. **Form a group:** Each group must include **one faculty member and up to two students**.
3. **Contact your institution:** Interested candidates should approach their Canadian higher education institution about the nomination process.
4. **Institutional nomination:** The Canadian institution submits/nominates the eligible group for the 2026 call.
5. **Follow AMEXCID requirements:** The institution and candidates should consult the official AMEXCID call for the required application documents and submission procedure. ([EduCanada](#))

6. **Participate if selected:** Successful groups undertake an academic and cultural stay of up to 30 days in Mexico during October–November 2026.

Application route: Through a **Canadian higher education institution (nominating institution)**, not directly through an embassy or individually. ([EduCanada](#))

Is this scholarship fully funded or tuition-only?

It is **not a tuition-only scholarship**. The 2026 program provides funding for **round-trip airfare, transportation within Mexico, and living expenses during the stay**. Tuition coverage is **not mentioned** in the official call.

Which nationalities and study levels are eligible?

The call is specifically for **Indigenous students and faculty members from Canadian post-secondary institutions**, including **First Nations, Inuit and Métis** participants. It is therefore **not open to applicants from other nationalities**.

Is university admission required before the scholarship application?

No separate university admission is required. The program is for Indigenous students and faculty members who are already affiliated with **Canadian post-secondary institutions**. Canadian higher education institutions nominate eligible participants for the short-term academic and cultural stay in Mexico.

What is the exact deadline and timezone?

The application deadline is **August 23, 2026, at 11:59 p.m. (Mexico City time)**.

Is there an application fee?

The official EduCanada announcement **does not mention any application fee**. Therefore, an application fee is **not confirmed** in the official call.
