



Jack Hirst Scholarship 2027-2028 at Imperial College London (ICL) in the UK Fully Funded

Description

The Jack Hirst Scholarship is offered by Imperial College London for the 2027-2028 academic cycle and is hosted in the UK. The award is intended for Nigerian students pursuing selected postgraduate Chemistry programmes at Imperial. One scholarship is available, providing full overseas tuition fees along with a stipend at the annual UKRI rate. Applicants may benefit from this opportunity if they are currently studying or conducting Chemistry research at a Nigerian academic institution and meet the programme and admission requirements. The application deadline for the 2027-2028 cycle is 21 May 2027.

Eligibility Criteria

- **Nationality:** Nigerian nationals only.
- **Academic Background:** Currently studying or conducting Chemistry research at a Nigerian academic institution.
- **Admission Requirement:** Must have an offer for an eligible Chemistry Master's course at Imperial College London.
- **Age Limit:** No specific age limit stated.
- **Work Experience:** No work experience requirement stated.
- **English Language:** No separate scholarship-specific requirement stated.
- **Nomination:** No nomination route; applicants must email the Chemistry Department to request consideration.
- **Student Status:** New entrants only; continuing students are not eligible.

How to Apply

1. **Apply for an eligible Chemistry programme** at Imperial College London.
2. **Obtain an offer** for an eligible programme.
3. **Prepare your scholarship application** according to the Chemistry Department's instructions.
4. **Email the Chemistry Department** at chemres@imperial.ac.uk to apply for consideration.
5. **Submit by 21 May 2027.**

Application route: Directly through **Imperial College London's Chemistry Department**. There is no embassy or external nominating agency route stated.

Required Documents

The current official scholarship page **does not specify a separate list of required documents** for the Jack Hirst Scholarship.

Therefore, do not list the following as confirmed requirements unless Imperial provides them later:

- Transcript
- Degree certificate
- CV
- Reference letters

- Research proposal
- English-language test result
- Passport copy

Is this scholarship fully funded or tuition-only?

It is **fully funded**. The scholarship covers **full overseas tuition fees** and provides a **stipend equivalent to the annual UKRI rate**.

Which nationalities and study levels are eligible?

The scholarship is open to **Nigerian nationals** applying for eligible **full-time postgraduate Chemistry programmes** at Imperial College London.

Is university admission required before the scholarship application?

Yes. Applicants must have an **offer for an eligible Chemistry programme at Imperial College London** before applying for the scholarship.

What is the exact deadline and timezone?

The application deadline is **21 May 2027**. The official Imperial College London page **does not specify a deadline time or timezone**.
