



National Bursary for Job-Generating Entrepreneurs 2026 in South Africa

Description

The National Bursary for Job-Generating Entrepreneurs 2026 is offered by [One Young World](#) to support young South African entrepreneurs whose businesses can create significant employment opportunities. The opportunity is linked to the One Young World Summit 2026, hosted in Cape Town, South Africa, from 3-6 November 2026. The current application cycle opened on 11 August 2026, with applications closing on 1 September 2026. South African entrepreneurs aged 18-30 who lead a job-generating business and have decision-making responsibility may benefit. Selected recipients receive fully funded Summit participation, travel, accommodation, mentorship, networking, and lifelong Ambassador Community membership.

Based on the official One Young World information I could verify, I would **not use Africa / Multiple countries as the host country**. The opportunity is associated with the **One Young World Summit 2026 in Cape Town, South Africa**.

Scholarship Overview

- **Host country:** South Africa - One Young World Summit 2026 will be held in **Cape Town from 3-6 November 2026**.

According to the official One Young World page, applicants must meet the following requirements:

- **Nationality:** Must be a **South African national**.
- **Residency:** Must currently **reside in South Africa**.
- **Age:** Applicants should generally be **18-30 years old**. Candidates over 30 may be considered if they demonstrate strong personal impact, initiative, and willingness to engage.
- **Academic qualifications:** **No specific academic qualification is required** or listed.
- **Work experience:** No specific employment or years-of-experience requirement is stated. However, applicants must be **leading a business or enterprise** with significant job-creation potential.
- **Entrepreneurial requirement:** Must lead a business or enterprise that has the potential to generate significant employment.
- **Leadership / decision-making:** Applicants must have **direct decision-making authority** within their organisation or company.
- **Language requirement:** **No specific English-language qualification or test requirement is stated.**
- **Availability:** Applicants must be available to attend the **One Young World Summit in Cape Town from 3-6 November 2026**.
- **Nomination route:** **No separate nomination requirement is listed.** The opportunity provides an application route through One Young World.

Important age note: Applicants who will be **under 18 at the time of the Summit cannot apply**. Candidates over 30 may still be considered at One Young World's discretion.

Available Fields or Programmes

4. Explain your business, leadership experience, and job-creation impact.
5. Submit your application before **1 September 2026**.
6. Wait for the selection results from One Young World.

Application route: Applicants apply **directly to One Young World**. No embassy, university, or separate nominating agency is required.

Required Documents

The official call does **not specify a separate list of supporting documents** such as:

- Academic transcripts

- Degree certificates
- CV/resume
- Reference letters
- Research proposal
- English-language test results
- Passport copy

Applicants should therefore **complete the online application form and provide the information requested by One Young World**. Avoid listing the above documents as mandatory unless the application form specifically requests them.
